Following two months of vegetation management on China Camp State Park land by the Marin County Tam Fire Crew, they are now ready to burn the piles they have created. Burning will more than likely begin the week of February 1<sup>st</sup>.

Dead trees, dead brush and invasive French Broom has been cut to and piled, at the minimum, 100 feet from the homes on Upper McNear. We are all breathing a sigh of safety with the Defensible Space they have created for these homes.
